

ME18b Grading Philosophy

Each homework problem is graded on a 10 point scale regardless of how long or difficult the problem is:

10 – Student correctly solved the homework problem and made some comments on the significance of the results or other observations showing some thought went into the analysis and assessment of the results.

9 – Student correctly solved the problem but did not make any comments or observations.

7 to 8 if minor mistakes were made and it looks like the student knew what they were doing but just was careless or missed a subtle point and worked the problem to completion.

4 to 6 if significant mistakes were made, the student appeared to not really know what to do or did not complete the problem solution.

1 to 3 if very little work is shown

0 if no work is done on a problem.
